Presenter Bill Ahearn— The Flintlock Long Arm in Colonial America

Bill Ahearn, a graduate of the United States Merchant Marine Academy at Kings Point, NY, a retired Lieutenant of the NYC Fire Department, a member of the New York Armor and Arms Club, and a member of the Sons of the American Revolution, will present "The Flintlock Long Arm in Colonial America" on Thursday, 19 March 2015 at the regular New Jersey Arms Collectors Club meeting.

Bill will illustrate his talk with about two dozen pieces from his and his wife's personal collection as he did last year when he spoke about the Brown Bess musket. He will discuss American, British, Dutch, and French arms. Bill has published *Muskets of the Revolution* and recently finished writing *Arms and Artifacts of the Burgoyne Expedition-1777*, to be published soon.

Bill Ahearn spoke last year on the Brown Bess musket at both NJACC and, earlier, to the American Revolutionary Round Table in Morristown. The quality and energy of his presentation recommend Bill Ahearn to this and many future meetings.
